### ALLEGATIONS OF PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT

- Failed to abide by a written undertaking given to the College (para. 54).

### BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF FACTS

- Member entered into a voluntary undertaking/agreement with the College in 2008 in order to address concerns related to his health.
- In 2009, member breached the undertaking/agreement.

### DECISION

#### 1. Finding

- The member pleaded guilty and was found guilty with respect to the above allegation.

#### 2. Penalty

- Reprimand
- Suspension of certificate of registration for one month (August 1 – 31, 2011)

#### 3. Costs/Publication

- Costs awarded to the College in the amount of \$2,000.
- Pursuant to the legislation, publication of this matter includes the member's name and address.

#### 4. Panel's Reasoning

- Penalty was a joint submission resulting from a pre-hearing conference.
- Member voluntarily sought and continues to receive appropriate treatment and is being monitored by the College.
- Member cooperated fully with the College.
- Member has no previous disciplinary findings.
- Penalty is proportionate to the circumstances.
- Public interest is protected by the member's ongoing undertaking/agreements with the College.
- Penalty provides a specific deterrence to the member and publication advises members of the profession that such conduct cannot be tolerated in a self-regulating profession.
