ALLEGATIONS OF PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT

- Failed to comply with an order of the Discipline Committee (para. 52)
- Disgraceful, dishonourable, unprofessional or unethical conduct (para.59)

BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF FACTS

Dr. Ohodronyk breached an order of the Discipline Committee dated March 26, 2013 by:

- failing to complete the professional ethics course, ordered by the committee, on time.
- failing to complete the recordkeeping course ordered by the Committee. While the member registered for the course, he failed to attend.

DECISION

1. Finding

The member pleaded guilty and was found guilty with respect to the above allegations of professional misconduct.

2. Penalty

- Reprimand
- Suspension of certificate of registration for nine months (January 26, 2016 – September 25, 2016)
- Practice to be monitored for three years

3. Costs/Publication

- Costs awarded to College in the amount \$10,000.
- Member to pay monitoring costs
- Pursuant to the legislation, publication of this matter includes the member's name and address.

PANEL'S REASONING

- The penalty was reached as a result of a pre-hearing conference.
- The proposed penalty was within the appropriate range for misconduct of this nature.
- The penalty was fair and protected the public interest, serving as a specific deterrent for the member and a general deterrent for the profession, and serving to rehabilitate the member and maintain public confidence in the profession.
- Although the member had previously shown disregard for the College's authority in his failure to comply with an order of the Discipline Committee, his admission of guilt demonstrates his acceptance of responsibility and remorse for his misconduct.
